

Donut Sort Student Instructions

1. Assign 1 donut to each person in your group and place into baggie.
2. Put your name on your baggie.
3. Discuss with your group about the different characteristics of the donuts.
4. Determine how you are going to sort and classify your donuts.
5. Create a dichotomous key based on the characteristics you chose.

EXAMPLE:

1A. Not round

1B. Round

2A. Not round, twisted

2B. Not round, not twisted

6. When you are done, create a drawing of all of the donuts. You must include the donut name and the name of the person who had that donut in their bag.

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
